



PRIVACY POLICY

From 25th May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) takes the place of the Data Protection Act. As a consequence, we are required to inform you of the personal information we keep about you and how we might then use that information.

When you become members of the Club, we ask you to complete a form which provides us with your name, address, contact telephone number and email address. The forms are retained on file which can be accessed by staff and Board Members only for the sole purpose of contacting you should a query arise. In addition, the information is held on a computer database which is password protected and shared by members of staff (the Stadium Manager and Deputies) and the Club's Treasurer. The database is used to generate address labels for membership renewal purposes - and to provide information required by the Welsh Indoor Bowling Association/Welsh Ladies Indoor Bowling Association to whom we pay a fee depending on your club affiliation. The details passed on to the W.I.B. are edited to show only your name and post code. The Club does not pass your details on to any other individual member, organisation or third party. However, we may from time to time pass on information to you which we consider to be of interest / benefit (i.e if a sponsor is making a specific offer to our members). We may also send messages via email informing you of matters directly affecting your membership or the Stadium's day-to-day activities. For those participating in the Winter Leagues, the Team Contact's name is posted to the Club's noticeboards, together with a telephone number (the telephone number is removed on the website). Similarly, players chosen to represent the Stadium in matches will have their names placed on the noticeboard and on the Club website.

Should you choose to have some or all of your details permanently removed from our files and database, please let us know. Paper copies will be destroyed and electronic data deleted.
