

I am writing regarding the Leagues.

If you remember my team had to withdraw from the league because games were not allowed to be rearranged even when bowlers could not play due to representing the club in matches taking place at the same time.

Other bowling clubs do allow league games to be rearranged with certain stipulations. My opinion is that SIBC should follow this.

The proposal I have for the forthcoming AGM is as follows.

This will benefit both the club (financially) and the teams involved being able to fulfil their fixtures.

"Any team not showing up for their league game/s will be expected to pay the green fees before they play their next scheduled game.

The game can then be rearranged with the agreement of both teams with no further fees incurred and with the permission of the league secretary. If any games are rearranged, they must be played within 14 days of the original fixture date."

I would please ask the board to consider introducing this rule into the league rule

handbook.
