

REVISED CAR PARKING ARRANGEMENTS AT SWANSEA INDOOR BOWLS CLUB

In response to numerous complaints from members and the disruption caused at peak times, the Club's Board members took the decision to install barriers at each of its two parking sites to ensure that those using the facility would not be inconvenienced by the lack of available parking spaces.

We are pleased to confirm that the barriers are now operational but before they are activated we need to make you aware of how they will work and your obligations as a card holder.

The process is as follows:

From week commencing 16th January 2017, Members who are eligible and **WHO REQUIRE** a car parking proximity card need to collect it from reception, together with a windscreen sticker which **MUST** be prominently displayed in the vehicle.

- The proximity card will be numbered to correspond with your membership card – which you must also present together with the registration number of the vehicle to which the card corresponds.
- You will be asked to sign a disclaimer to show that you have read and accept the Terms & Conditions which are shown overleaf.
- The proximity card will be validated for both car parks. On arrival at the barrier simply show the proximity card to the number pad on entry. On departure, the barrier will rise automatically.
- The card is for the sole use of the named member using the facility for the **purpose of playing bowls**. It is only to be used in conjunction with the vehicle to which it is issued and under no circumstances should the card be passed on to any other individual including other members.
- Lost / Stolen / Broken cards must be reported to Reception as soon as possible after discovery of Loss / Theft / Breakage. In all cases replacement cards will be only be provided upon payment of a £30 fee. Lost / Stolen card replacements will be issued 1 month after notification. Broken cards will be exchanged upon presentation of the broken card to reception and payment of the replacement card fee.
- Bowlers arriving without their card will not be able to access either parking facility and will be required to park elsewhere.
- As now there will be four Disabled spaces set aside outside the barriers of the Bowling Green car park. These spaces will carry new signage stipulating that they are for Bowls Club Members use only. Members using these spaces must display a 'Blue Badge' and have a car park sticker on their windscreen. The three disabled spaces alongside reception will also carry new signage stipulating that they are for Bowls Club Members use only. Members using these spaces must display a 'Blue Badge' and have a car park sticker on their windscreen. It should be noted that the parking bay nearest to reception doors is FOR WHEELCHAIR USERS ONLY.
- We strongly recommend that you keep your proximity card in your vehicle at all times as there is no intercom connection with reception to activate the barriers.
