Leagues will take place on Mon, Wed & Fri from 10:00HRS - 12:00HRS

Leagues are open to all including non-members

The cost to play will be £5 per player per match. CARD PAYMENT ONLY

Dress will be white above the waist (or recognised bowls shirt), grey below together with regulation <u>bowling</u> shoes

Players should arrive by 09:45 AT THE VERY LATEST and register at reception

Doors open at 09.30 (access will not be permitted any earlier)

Depending on the number of players present the Stadium Manager/Duty Officer will determine the playing format for that day, Pairs, Triples, Fours or a mixture.

The Stadium Manager/Duty Officer will draw the teams from those players registered for that day's play. i.e. in Triples first 3 players will play in Team 1, second 3 players in Team 2 etc.

Playing positions will be determined by the draw i.e. the first player drawn will play Lead, last player drawn will be Skip (in accordance with players' vote 2013)

Rinks will also be determined by the draw i.e. first two teams drawn will play on rink 1 second two teams drawn will play on rink 2 etc.

There will be a separate League for each day with awards given out at Presentation Day to the top three players in respect of each of the 3 daily leagues.

Each player will be awarded 2 points for a win and 1 point for a draw for each match played

League positions will be calculated by dividing the total accumulated points by the number of matches played to realise an average point total. In the event of a tied points average positions will be determined by shot difference followed by shots scored. In this way it is hoped to accommodate holidays, illness and late entrants.

To qualify for any of the League Tables a player must play in at least 50% of the matches in that month/season.

In the event of there being more participants than we are able to accommodate, priority will be given to Club Members in the first instance and thereafter, the first 48 names drawn from the hat will play. Those not drawn will be asked to stand down and their £5 rink fee refunded in full.
