Club Tournaments Rules

FORMAT

SINGLES (4 bowls)

Games will be first player to 21 SHOTS. Players *MUST* provide their own markers.

PAIRS (4 bowls)

Games will be 21 ends or 4 hours play, whichever comes first.

TRIPLES (3 bowls)

Games will be 18 ends or 4 hours play, whichever comes first.

FOURS (2 bowls)

Games will be 21 ends or 4 hours play, whichever comes first.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE AFFILIATED TO SWANSEA IBC

DRAW/PLAYING SCHEDULE

The Draw and Playing Schedule will be posted on the Stadium Tournament Notice Board and club website at least 5 days before the commencement of the Tournaments. **All rounds for all tournaments MUST be completed on or before the due date displayed.** The Match Secretary reserves the right to alter dates and times to the Tournament draw but will in all circumstances do so in plenty of time and will contact the affected competitors.

SUBSTITUTES

In Pairs, Triples & Fours, one substitute will be allowed provided they have not already played in the competition. The substitute can play in any position and is available for all rounds.

LATE ARRIVALS

All participating players should be present at the commencement of a match. In the event of a player being absent at the designated start time, a period of 15 minutes shall be allowed. If after 15 minutes the player has not arrived a substitute can play. If no substitute is available, the match shall be awarded to the opponents. Matches with a delayed start will not have any time extension and will finish at the time designated.

DURATION

All matches to be played 'bell' to 'bell' or the ends specified whichever comes first. No allowance is to be made for a match starting late due to the rink being occupied.

In Pairs, Triples and Fours matches Leads/Seconds/Thirds cannot visit the head until all their bowls have been delivered. Skips may only re-visit the head prior to delivering their final bowl.



DRAWN MATCHES

All matches played as per the Tournament Schedule's designated time and date ending with the scores level **will** play an extra end to decide the outcome.

DEAD ENDS

All stadium competition matches will adopt the BIBC format regarding dead ends. This means that in the case of the jack going off the side of the rink the jack will be placed on the nearest re-spot mark. Any jack driven over the ditch to be replaced on the 'T'.

WITHDRAWING FROM A GAME

If you withdraw your name or names from any competition match that has been drawn **you will still have to pay the rink fees.**

DRESS CODE

For matches up to and including the Semi-Finals the dress code shall be bowls tops above the waist (with sleeves), regulation bowls trousers, skirts or shorts below the waist and regulation bowling shoes. **For all finals the dress code shall be bowls tops, white bowls trousers, skirts or shorts and regulation bowling shoes.** Any players not complying with the dress code will be asked to leave the green.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are

- £6 per singles entry
- £12 per pairs entry
- £18 per triples entry
- £24 per fours entry.

No Tournament entries will be accepted without the appropriate fee.

When submitting the relevant entry form, individuals/teams will be required to state if they do NOT wish to be considered for inclusion in the relevant WIB qualifying matches.

RINK FEES

Rink Fees payable before commencement of all matches are:

- £6 per player per game
- Fees for all team games (pairs, triples, fours) must be paid for in one transaction for each team.

ALL FEES TO BE PAID BY CARD.

All tournament games must be played on the allocated rinks.

Closing date for entries is **as advertised** - after which time the draws will be made. **No further entries will be accepted after the draw has been made.**

Any queries/disputes should be brought to the Match Secretary's attention with the relevant details at the earliest opportunity in order for an informed decision to be made.
